## STEP 2

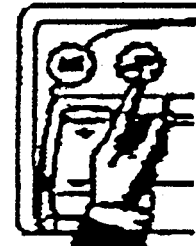
SIMULTANEOUSLY

SELECTION BUTTON.

## STEP 3

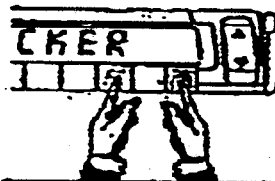
WITHIN 4 SECONDS  
PRESS THE SEEK UP  
BAR UNTIL SERIAL N IS  
REACHED.

## STEP 4

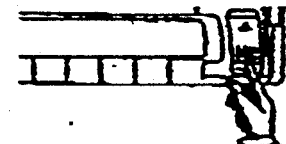
PRESS THE BUTTON  
UNDER THE RIGHT  
ARROW NEAR THE  
CENTER OF THE RADIO.  
THE SERIAL NUMBER  
OF THE RADIO WILL BE  
DISPLAYED. CONTINUE  
PRESSING THE SEEK  
UP BUTTON UNTIL END  
APPEARS IN THE  
DISPLAY. THE RADIO  
WILL RETURN TO  
NORMAL OPERATION IN  
ABOUT 5 SECONDS.



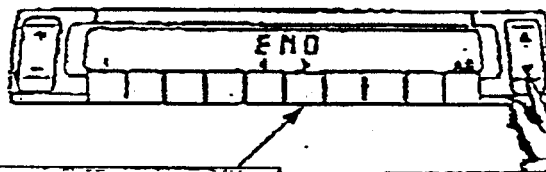

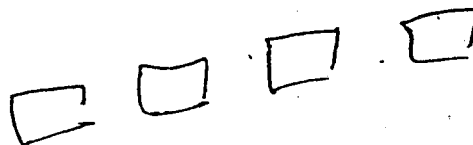

### Displaying the Serial Number on Becker CDR220 & CR220 Radios

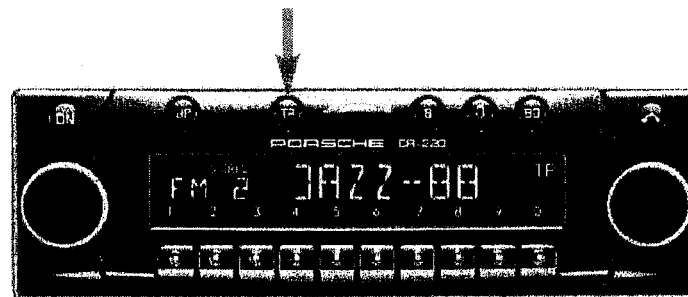

Information: To display the serial number on a Becker 220 radio with out removing the radio, perform the following procedure:

1. Turn the radio on.
2. Depress and hold The T/P button and hold for Ten seconds, Then the face will Display Becker 1
3. Release the T/P button.
4. Turn the right tuning knob until you reach the Serial number.
